

Control Centre (CC)

The wiring of the Yerriyong tiles is making steady progress. The tiles should be put back in place soon and then will start to come alive. The tiles will be very dynamic right from the start, point indication, block indication, signal indication and in the longer term train numbers.

Master Brake

The new Master Brake system has been switched over and the old Master Brake button has passed into history. Four new buttons have been installed and wired so far with more on the way.

Instruction Manual

A need was identified to have an Instruction Manual for the operation of the Control Centre.

The format of this manual is still to be worked out. So far the efforts of a few people are encouraging.
