Opening Times

NCE Throttles

There are a growing number of controllers that are damaged and in need of repair or replacement. It is near on impossible to get parts or new controllers at the moment. On top of the unavailability of units, the cost is something the club is not in a position to afford at this time. The committee asks all members, where you have a compatible controller or smart device that can be used as a controller please bring and use this as the preference. There are still some functioning controllers at the club, but the numbers of these is shrinking and we want to keep these for members that don't have their own controller and visitors.

This is your opportunity as members to make suggestions, ask questions of the committee and, to generally find out what's happening around the club. Prior to this members forum the committee will be holding a COM meeting on Sunday 14th January 2024. Constitutional Changes

Prior to this years AGM, the club held a SGM to pass several special resolutions to amend 2 clauses in the NSW constitution. Whilst the changes were in themselves minor, it is no minor thing to make the changes. We have ticked the first requirement to make the changes by passing the special resolutions needed. The next step in the process is to lodge the changes with NSW Dept of Fair Trading to have effectively the new/updated constitution registered. This step could take a little bit of time as it will be mixed up with the changing of the Public Officer as well as the Christmas/new year period.

Once the committee gets a response for Fair Trading we will let all the members know. One thing members have to remember, until the constitution is registered by Fair Trading, we have to operate under the old rules. Should for some reason the changes be rejected then we will have to continue operating under the old constitution.
